2. Final assignment

The final assignments consist of three parts:

- 1. A pitch
- 2. A report
- 3. An individual reflection video

The pitch

On Monday, teachers will form groups of 4 to 6 students of various countries and studies. During the week, with your group, you will produce an **ArtIST story**: you need to reinterpret the spirit of the ArtIST program and blend the things that you know as a student and the things that you will see and learn during the summer school, in order to design a



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story following the lines of storytelling. The subject of the story is free (it can be related to an idea, a product or a service of your interest), but it should be related to "Il bello" experience.

You will have to create an account on a social media tool (the decision of which tool is up to each group) on the second day. There you will collect all the material that you will produce during the summer school (photos, thoughts, learnings, etc.), using it as a creative repository. In this way, you will start to get familiar with the tool and use it as a storytelling platform. But the most important part of your group work will be the definition of the concept of the story. That will be the framework of your ArtIST story. It will set three important things:

- the fictional world of your story;
- its tone of voice;
- the typology of people that you want to engage in your storytelling.

Once the concept is set, you will edit the contents that you put on the social media tool and create new ones, in order to create a social media campaign that will be consistent with the concept that you chose. You will be given support during the week to develop en produce your ArtIST story.

The final (collective) pitch that will be held on Friday 16th will have to be based on the skills you learned during the week. In the final pitch, you will have to show your ArtIST story: you will present the concept and the social media campaign where you implemented it. In other words, you will tell us an engaging story using the social media tool, and then show the thread that you made up and the clear message that you want to spread. The link needs to be submitted via email normarosso@santannapisa.it.

More information will be given at the beginning of the summer school. You do not need to prepare for this activity.

The report

With 4 or 5 students of your own choice (max. of 5 students in one group) you work on a report (max. of 10 pg). The report will have to contain the following topics:

- Describe the entrepreneurial ecosystem in your country / region
- Develop and tell an engaging ArtIST story based on this ecosystem
- Explain the reason why you chose this concept in relation to what you experienced during the summer school (approx. 3 pg)
- How does this concept differ from or resemble the concept you presented in Pisa

Information to make this report should be gained via interviews of artists and entrepreneurs, literature studies, experiments with social media, etc... The report (In Arial 11p) will consist of the following sections:

- description of your country's entrepreneurial ecosystem (approx. 3 pg)
- your concept (approx. 3 pg)
- a methodology section (1 pg.)
- a management summary of the three points above (1 page)

The report needs to be submitted via email normarosso@santannapisa.it on the latest on October 17, 2022, grading and substantiation will be given the latest on October 31st.





The individual reflection video

The reflection video of 3 to 5 minutes, you reflect on the summer school as a whole and your personal learning objective(s). An objective of STEAM education is to increase students' creativity skills. What skills did you develop? In your video you describe your personal learning objectives and reflect on what skills you have developed during the course. We also look forward to how you would use these skills in your future work.

3. Course Assignments

Individual reflections

At the end of each day of the summer school a reflection has to be submitted. We choose to do this via the app Telegram. Each day in the morning you will get reflection questions via the chat. Each evening the app will be open to upload your answers. The individual reflection consists of 2 parts:

- 3 photos with titles and short descriptions of the brightest moments of your day
- and key takeaways on the activities during the day to be submitted via the provided link.

The reflection needs to be submitted, but will not be graded. They are considered as formative assessments that will help you to make your final assignment. However, not submitting the reflections will end up in failing the course.

In-class and home tasks regarding different lectures

Each day there will be a mix of lectures and class assignments. During the course more information will be given regarding the assignments by the involved teachers. Homework, pre-class and class assignments are obligatory as well as involvement during class, see below.

4. Assessment criteria and grading

Students having successfully finished the course assignments will receive 5 ECTS from LUT (Finland) and grading 0-5 evaluation or Pass / Fail depending on your university requirements.

The assessment criteria for the pitch are:

- Involvement during classes
- Originality and creativity
- Relevance of content

The assessment criteria for the report, social and video are:

- Clarity and style
- Originality and creativity
- Relevance of content

All criteria must be at least sufficient and will be evaluated using the grading system described below:



Main locations of the Summer School in Pisa City Center


